**The Falklands War, 2 April–14 June 1982.** Michael Rondot's dramatic painting captures the power & beauty of the mighty Handley Page Victor in action during Operation BLACK BUCK, the name given to the series of extreme long-range attacks on the airfield at Stanley, East Falkland. Vulcans from Ascension Island flew the 15-hour round trip, attacking the runway and airfield installations with 1000lb bombs and targeting radar sites with AGM-45 Shrike missiles.

The Vulcan missions required multiple refuelling, using as many as 18 Victor K2 tanker aircraft sorties with the aircraft operating in concert, including tanker-to-tanker refuelling. The Royal Air Force had never flown anything remotely resembling the scale of this complicated operation. It was a success because of the determination, courage, ingenuity and resourcefulness of the air and ground crews involved in the operations, but the shining star was the Victor K2.

Vulcan bombers wore the laurels after the Falklands War, but it fell to the Victor tankers, their aircrews, ground and engineering support to make any of it possible.
